2. Special Lecture On Digital Finance Literacy : (Vittiya Saksharata Abhiyana (VISAKA)

As per the UGC guideline letter sent through VC, VSKUB dated 5th December 2016, based on the MHRD Govt. of India programme, Vittiya Saksharata Abhiyana (VISAKA) to promote digital economy in our college was organised jointly by our college NSS and NCC Units. A special lecture was arranged on 06/01/2017 at 11:30 AM at out college seminar hall for our students to create awareness about the Digital Finance Transactions (cashless). For this digital finance transactions awareness programme Sri.Ravi Jadi, District Level Resource Person was invited. In his special lecture firstly he explained our students about why and how to make our all cash transactions to cashless as visualized by the present Modi Government to knockout black money, corruption and empowerment of the poor.



Throughout his ppt lecture, he tried to create interest and awareness about the digital finance system in this digital era linking through one's own mobile and smart phone, aadhara no's using User Id and Password (operated secretly).

Similarly, he also explained in his power point presentation about different modes of Digital Payment 'APP'(which are to be downloaded into

- 7) BHIM (Bharat Interface of Money)

Sri Ravi also explained in detail about the different types of Fund Transfers (Its methods & objectives) from one's own bank account to another man's account through NEFT, RTGS, ECS, IMPS. 7. Celebrations of Dr. B.R.Ambedikar Jayanti :


Dr. B.R.Ambedikar Jayanti was organized by NSS Units in Devalapur Village on 18th April 2018 to create awareness about the Importance of Education.

2. A fond remembrance of Subhashchandra Bhose & his Achievements :

Subhash Chandra Bhose was an Indian Freedom Fighter, Nationalist whose defiant patriotism made him a hero in India. He was the president of Indian National Congress from 1938 to 1939. He attempted to ruled out Britishers in India during the world war II with the help of Nazi Germary and Impertial Japan.



Recently in view of the release of 30 files/letter relating to Subhashchandra Bose, from 1937 to 1947, by the West Bengal government, a student's discussion programme was arranged on 26th September 2015 for our BA students in the college seminar hall at 11:30 AM

Initially, Prof. Sharanabasappa Biliyeli has moderated the discussion. Principal, Sri.M.S.Dadmi, Dr.J.S.Patil and few staff members of Arts faculty and students were present on this occasion. As many as 10 BA students have come with preparation on the topic was informed earlier. The discussion part was concentration on the sudden disappearance of Sri.Subhashchandra Bose from the National Freedom Movement. Does Subhash death was due to plane crash or not ? What is the truth about the incidental news appeared and later secret correspondence held with Russian government and prominent Indian leaders in India. Students in their discussion citing the examples, evidences of various committee report instituted on Subhashchandra Bose.

The questions are significant as many in the Bose's family as well as followers of Netaji and researchers believe that he had faked his death in the so called plane crash in 1945 to avoid being captured as a war criminal by allied forces. We are convinced that Netaji did not die in 1945 but he could not comeout in the open because of the "war criminal tag". Why a National Icon's name would figure in a cell that should deal with extremists and other types of criminals.

The programme was useful to the students in collecting historical facts and reports relating to our national history. As such, it inculcates the research bent of mind to our students.

3. National Youth Day

A Jatha was organized on 12th January 2016, on the eve of National Youth Week. Nearly more than 350 students were participated in the Jatha. Swami Vivekananda's principles and values were spread.
